The audit committee is an independent committee formed by a decision of the company's Ordinary General Assembly. The audit committee is concerned with monitoring the company's business and verifying the integrity and integrity of the reports, financial statements, and internal control systems therein. And accounting policies and supervision of the work of internal auditing and external auditors.

The committee held 4 (Four) meetings during the FY 2022G, and its activities within the scope of its competence as following:

- Supervising the internal audit department and following up on the implementation of the approved audit plan for the year 2022.
- Examining the internal audit reports and following up on the implementation of the important recommendations contained in the internal audit reports.
- Examining all related party deals as defined by the applicable rules and regulations.
- Study the effectiveness of the process of identifying, assessing, and reporting on significant risks to the company's activity, and the company's management method for those risks, and submitting appropriate recommendations in this regard to the Board of Directors.
- Study the preliminary and annual financial statements for the fiscal year ending on 31/12/2022 and the auditor's notes on the financial statements and follow up on what has been done about them, and the results of the company's financial year review with the appropriate external auditors and management representatives and raise the recommendation for consideration for approval to the Board of Directors.

- Studying the auditor's offers and recommending the appointment of the auditor for the year ending 12/31/2023.

- Review accounting policies and practices, including the consistency of these policies, annually.

It submits to the Council a periodic report on the examinations carried out by the committee, and its recommendations in this regard.
